ITEM 1: OPENING

1. At 1800h, 18 Apr 15 the chair declared the meeting open and all members were welcomed to the fifth Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the ADFWGA. The chair gave a brief introduction of the committee then gave an outline of the conduct of the meeting as well as the process of raising motions and accepting motions. The Chair explained the movement of the AGM to the ANZAC Cup for 2015 and stated that the location of future AGMs would be based of attendance at future ADFWGA events.

ITEM 2: CONFIRMATION OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES

2. The Chair stated that the minutes from the 2014 ADFWGA AGM had been compiled by CAPT C. Bryers and had been posted on the ADFWGA website for the previous two months. The chair went through the action items from the 2014 ADFWGA AGM, all of which had been completed. These included:

a. **Administrative Instructions.** An event Administrative Instruction for the ANZAC Cup had been compiled and made available to members to assist unit administrative requirements.

b. **Details for 2015 Events.** Details for 2015 ADFWGA events had been promulgated (ANZAC Cup and Wingman) and will continue to be developed for future events.

c. **Honorary Members.** The list of Honorary Members has been updated to reflect the changes made at the 2014 AGM.

d. **2015 ADFWGA Constitution.** The Constitution (Jan 2015) incorporating the changes made at the 2014 AGM has been uploaded to the ADFWGA website.

3. The Chair motioned to have the minutes of the 2014 AGM accepted as no comments were received on the accuracy of the minutes. **Proposed by:** Sam Vardy. **Seconded by:** Rick Vandermast. The 2014 AGM Minutes were accepted as a true and accurate record of the meeting.

ITEM 3: COMMITTEE ORDINARY MEMBER

4. As per the discussion at the 2014 AGM, it had been decided that a fourth committee position would be created to understudy the Vice Chair and Secretary, as well as support future event planning. The Chair explained the election process as outlined in the Constitution. One nomination had been received from CAPT Bryan Yarrington. The nomination was supported by Scott Livori and Dave Hill. Bryan Yarrington was elected unopposed.

ITEM 3: ADFWGA UPDATE

5. The Chair provided an update on the ADFWGA:

a. **ADFWGA Profile.** The Chair outlined the increasing profile of the association which has resulted in transport and accommodation support for ADFWGA events. The success of the ANZAC Cup will hopefully increase awareness of the ADFWGA in Brisbane, in particular with the Brisbane based command structure.

b. **Soldier On Recognition.** In January Mitch Wade, Luke Baldacchino and the Chair presented the 2014 donation to Soldier On. Soldier On has recently opened their new national headquarters in Canberra and the Chair noted the recognition of the ADFWGA efforts on the key supporters board at Soldier On HQ. This is a significant achievement for an association as small (but growing) as the ADFWGA. Soldier On has also offered the use of their facilities to the ADFWGA to support the conduct of events in Canberra.

c. **AHQ Sponsorship.** The Chief of Army has offered to raise his annual commitment to the ADFWGA to \$5,000. It is important that the ADFWGA demonstrate that this money will be appropriately utilised. Members are encouraged to utilise the funds in travelling to ADFWGA events and to assist in recruiting new members from localities around Australia to do the same.

ITEM 4: REPORTS

6. **Sponsors Report.** The 2014 sponsorship report is attached to the 2014 AGM minutes. 2015 has seen an increase in sponsors through persistent communication between the ADFWGA Committee and members of the hobby community, Australian and International. Of particular note is the partnership being formed between the ADFWGA and Jolt Games to bring ADFWGA events to Canberra. It is encouraged that ADFWGA members utilise those organisations that sponsor our association to give back to the hobby community that supports us.

ITEM 5: 2015/2016 ADFWGA EVENTS

7. The Chair confirmed the details and structure of the upcoming events for 2015. The current schedule of events is as follows:

a. **Sydney Event.** Due to the possible reorganization of The Combat Company's main gaming area, the proposed 2015 Sydney event may not occur. More information to follow with Canberra being a possible fall back option if interest is significant enough.

Action: The Committee will review the Sydney event post 02 May 15 and determine if the proposed event can be run or if it is to be moved to Canberra.

b. **Canberra Event.** The first official ADFWGA Canberra event (Wingman) will occur on 02 May 15 with the X-wing Tournament. The event will be held at the newly opened Soldier On centre and currently has 28 confirmed players. Depending on success and interest, further 2015 Canberra events are a possibility.

Action: Post 02 May 15 the Committee will review the event to determine if future Canberra events are feasible.

c. **Townsville Event.** The Townsville Event will be held from 11 to 13 Dec 15. The decision was upheld to restructure the event into three single day events. There will be one day for the major systems (40k, Bolt Action, WHFB and 30k), one day for novelty gaming and events (Board games, painting/hobby classes, doubles/Apocalypse games) and one day for skirmish games (X-wing, Infinity, Kill Team). The focus of the event will be on having fun, raising money and socialising. Ideas are currently being considered for campaign/narrative driven scenarios for the major systems to move even further away from a traditional tournament atmosphere. All suggestions from members are welcome and are already being collected.

d. **Brisbane Event.** With the ANZAC Cup being such a resounding success in 2015, the format will remain generally unchanged for 2016. The only fix that the Committee identified would be to further reinforce with the participants the "fun" nature of the event (combined with stricter list control) to dissuade any WAAC lists. The Chair proposed that civilian involvement be continued for the 2016 event. **Proposed by:** Dave Hill. **Seconded by:** Aaron Wright. Proposal passed.

Action. The ADFWGA Committee are to engage with ADFWGA members to ascertain preferences and suggestions for the running of the major systems tournaments for the 2015 Townsville Event.

ITEM 6: GENERAL BUSINESS

8. **Honorary Members.** There was nil change to the honorary members.

9. **Constitutional Amendment.** An amendment was proposed by the chair for Clause 8, paragraph 8.5 of the ADFWGA Constitution. The amendment was to change the words "financial year" to "calendar year," proposed so as to better line up ADFWGA AGM's with the ADFWGA events. **Proposed by:** Dave Hill. **Seconded by:** James Keller. Proposal passed.

Action: The Constitution is to be updated and posted on the ADFWGA website.

ITEM 7: OPEN FLOOR FOR GENERAL BUSINESS

10. The Chair opened the floor to the members present at the AGM for items of general business.

11. **Sponsorship and Support.** A discussion was held between the members of the AGM on possible sponsors to contact in 2015 to further increase support for ADFWGA events. The organisations mentioned were Victoria Miniatures, Virgin Airlines (and potentially other airlines as well) and Hobby Matrix. Any further suggestions from ADFWGA members are always welcome.

Action. The Secretary is to get in contact with these organisations to ascertain any potential support for future events.

12. **ADFWGA Event Advertising.** Members showed enthusiasm to advertise and rouse up support for ADFWGA events within their home locations. It was asked if a standard template poster/flyer could be developed and promulgated to enhance ADFWGA exposure in new locations.

Action. The Committee is to design and release advertising flyers/posters in the lead up to ADFWGA events to increase exposure, participation and general membership.

13. **AGM Location.** As outlined in the 2014 AGM, the location of the AGM will be rotated amongst the event locations. The Committee will use attendance numbers to determine the most suitable location for the AGM each calendar year. Members will be notified of the AGM IAW the ADFWGA Constitution.

14. **Renaming of “Townsville/December Event”.** It was noted that some of the ANZAC Cup’s success may have been due to its name, benefiting from the good ethos behind ANZAC Day and generally just being catchier than “(insert city/month here) event.” Members were asked to provide any suggestions and ideas for the renaming of the Townsville/December event.

Action. The Committee is to collect suggestions for and propose a new name for the Townsville/December event.

15. There being no other business, the 2015 AGM was concluded at 1833h, 18 Apr 15 with all matters closed.
